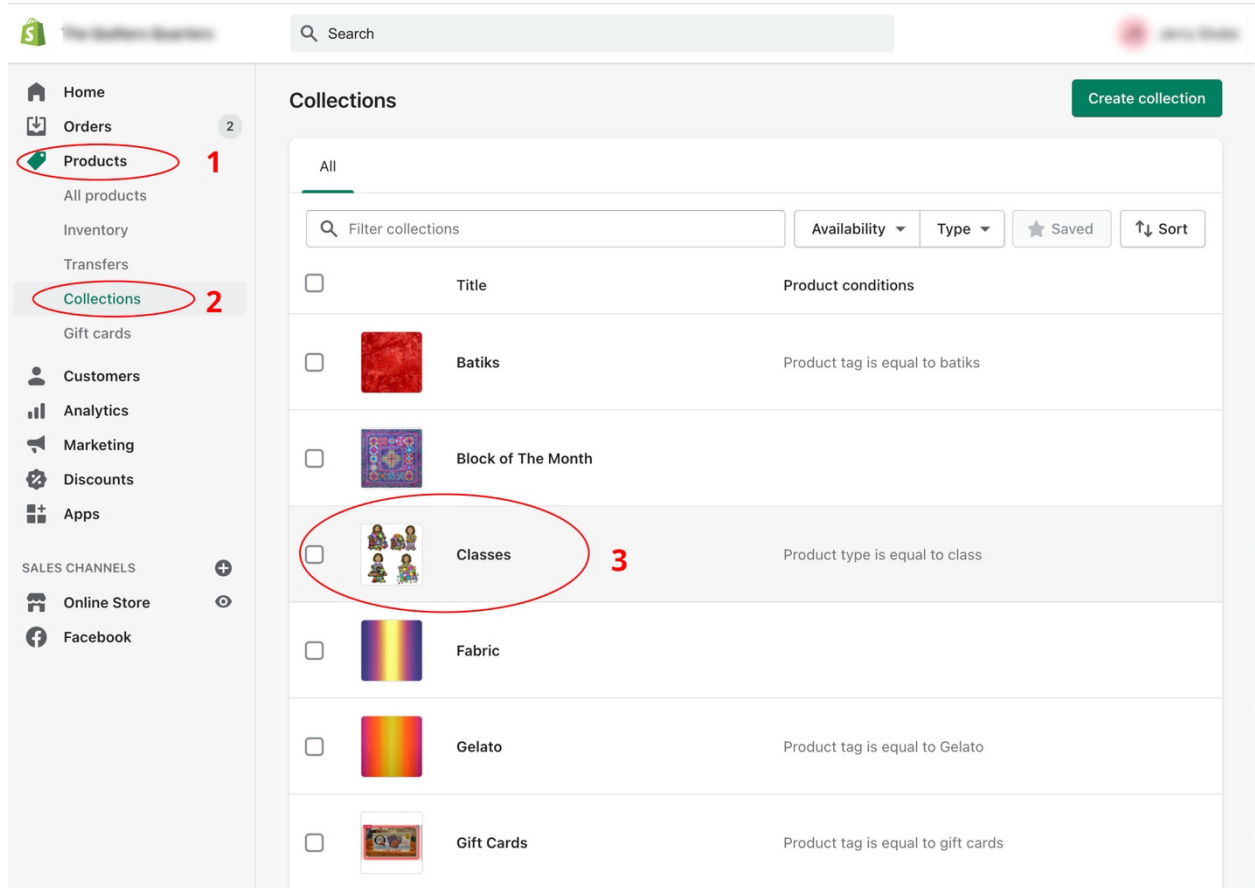


# General directions for adding the FabShop Hop Bunnies to Shopify

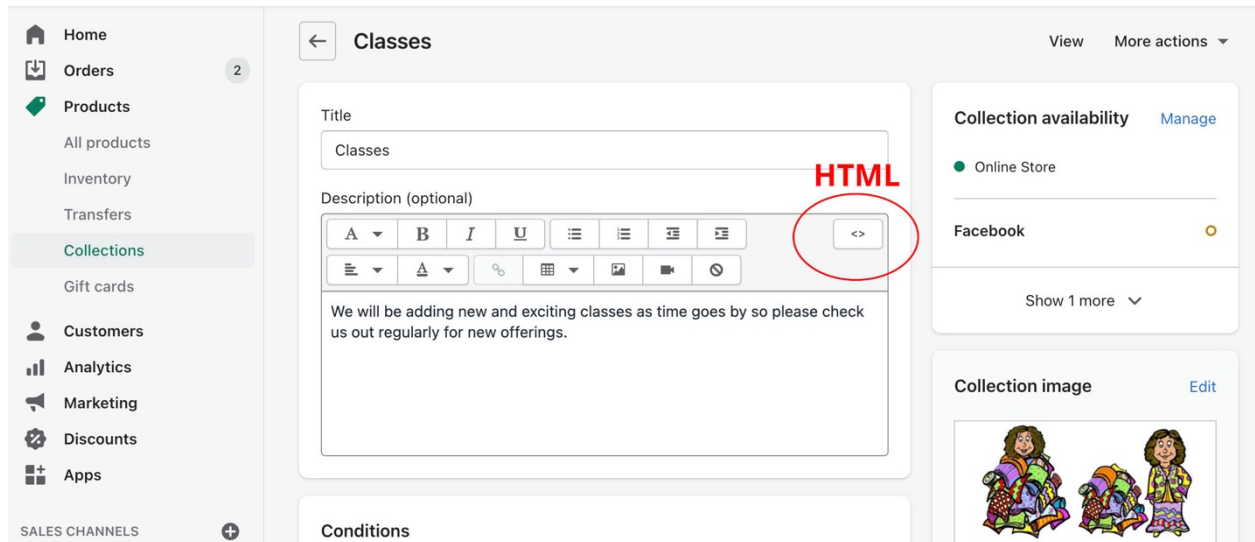
## Adding the “YouFoundIt” Bunny to show in a specific Collection (department):

From the Admin Home Screen:

1. Click on Products
2. Click on Collections
3. Choose the collection to add “YouFoundIt” Bunny

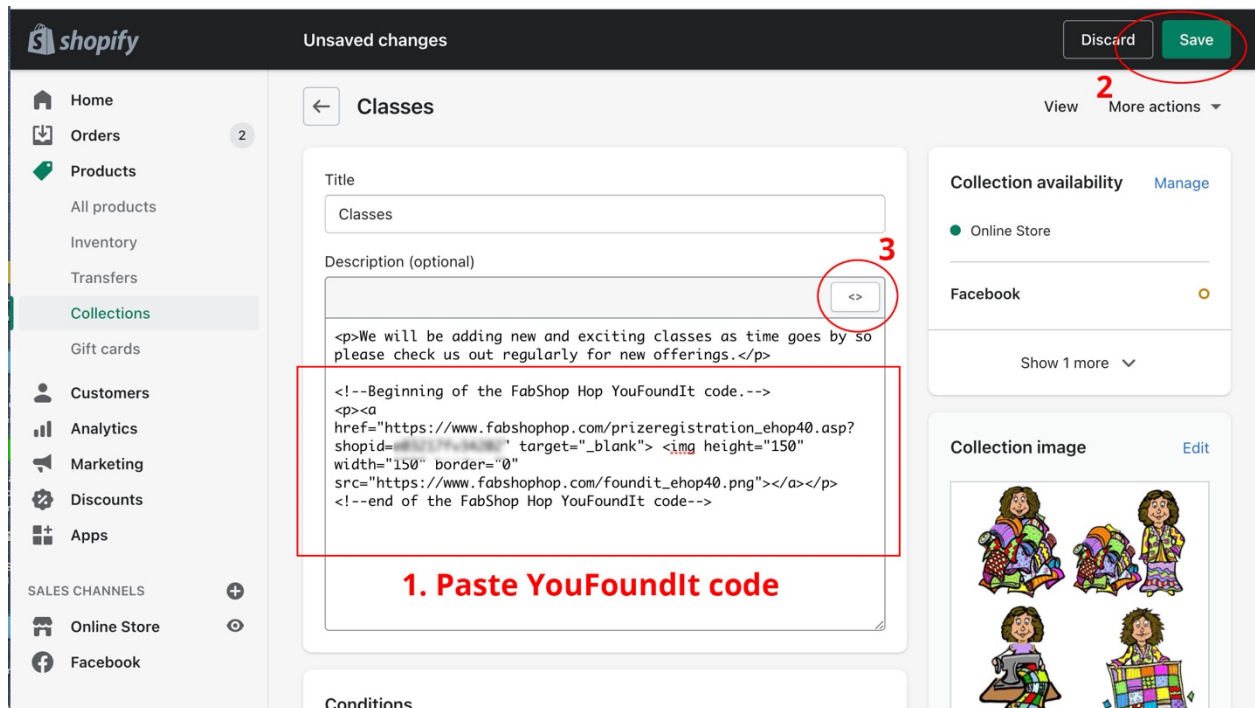


## 1. In the Collection page, find the HTML button in the Descriptions Window



### In the HTML widow:

- Paste the “YouFoundIt” code beneath your collection description.
- Save
- Click the HTML button to return the editor.

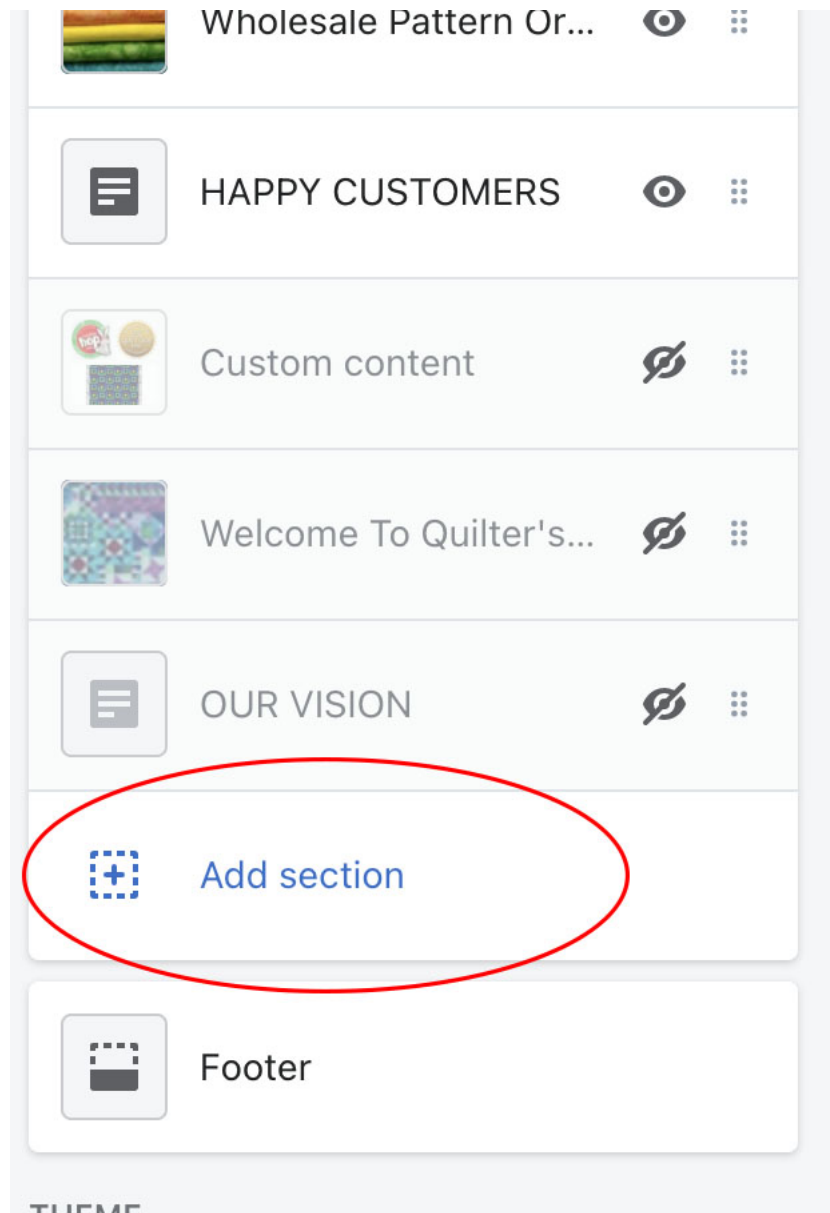

## Adding the Front Page Bunny to the Home Page

From the Admin Home screen:

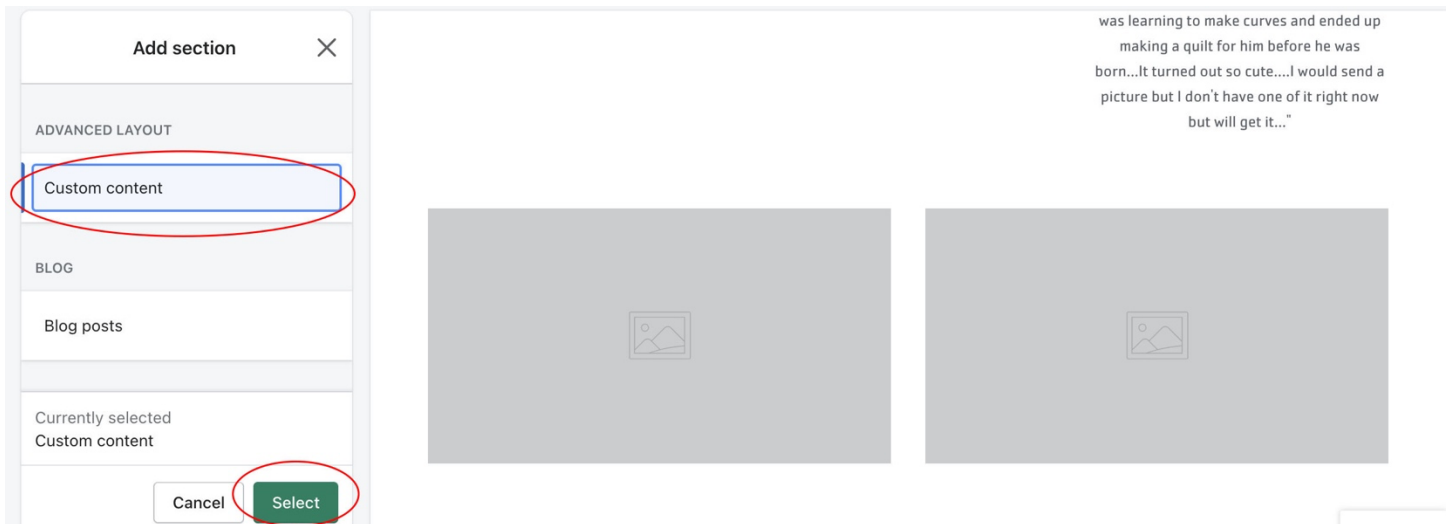
- Click **Online Store** on the left
- Click **Customize** on the right

Once you are in the Customize Home Screen, scroll down to the bottom of the selections on the left of the screen to find **Add Section**.



### Find a new section that offers Custom HTML.

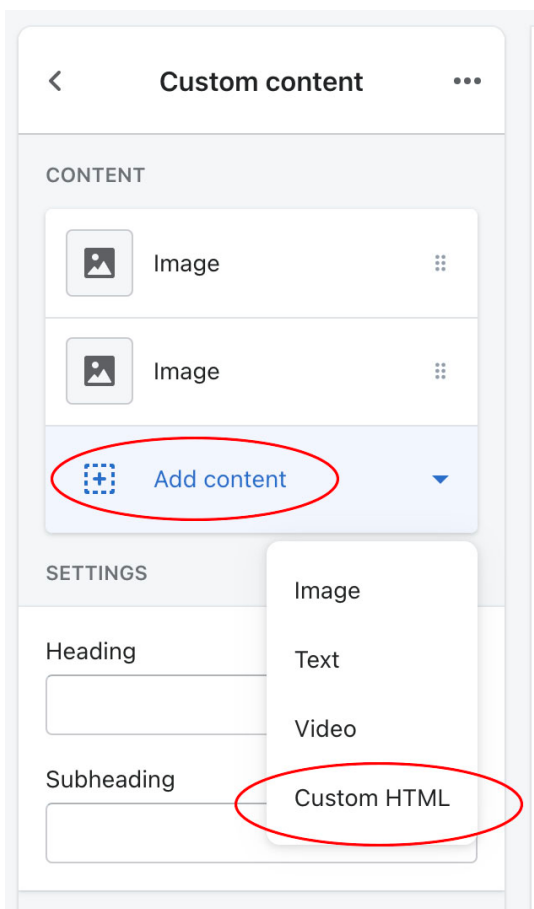
- In this example template, the Custom Content offers Custom HTML (yours may be a little different)
- Choose Select



### In the Custom Content section

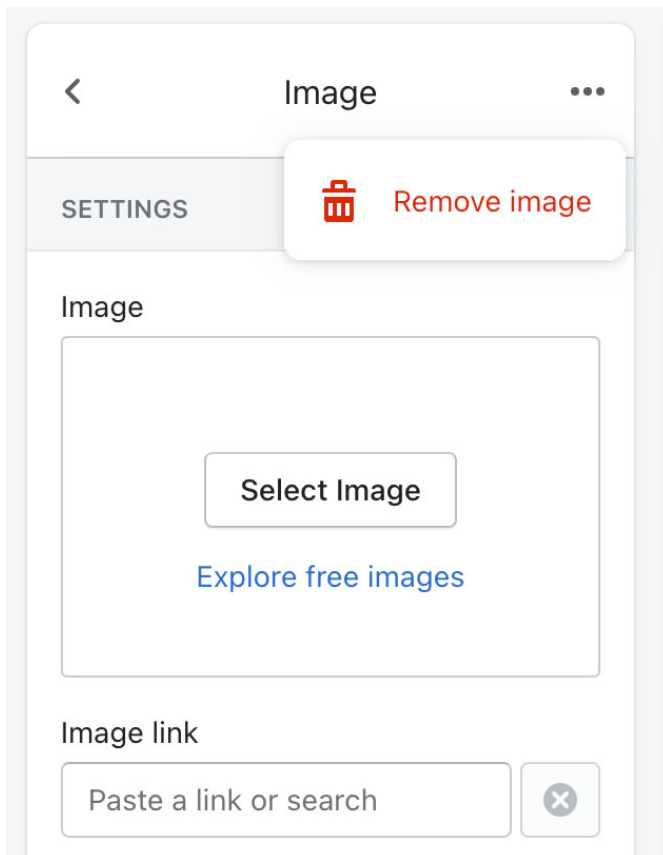
- Add Content
- Choose Custom HTML

1. Add your Front Page Code in the HTML window.
2. Choose Save
3. Go back to Custom content screen



**Deleted any existing sections except the one you just made.**

In this case, click on the image section, select the 3 dots on right, then choose the trash can.

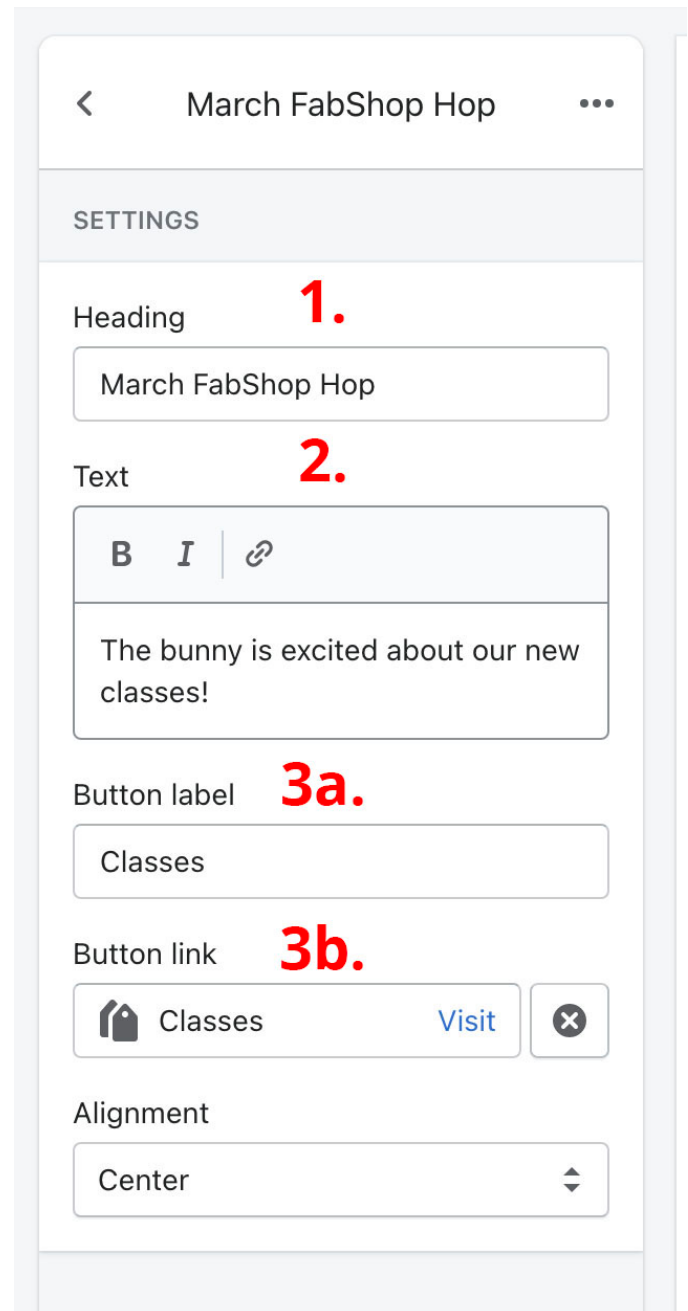


**Add another section.**

Choose a “Text” section (for rich text).

This section is where you can place your:

1. Heading
2. Bunny location hint
3. Link to the “YouFoundIt” bunny location (if you wish)



Go back to the Custom Content screen

Add another Custom HTML section to the Custom Content section.

Add this HTML as a placeholder.

```
<p><!--placeholder--></p>
```

*Note: This third sections helps keep the third column open and forces the bunny image to a normal size. Experiment in taking this one out to see if it is needed or not.*

Experiment with moving these 3 sections up and down to see what works best for you.
