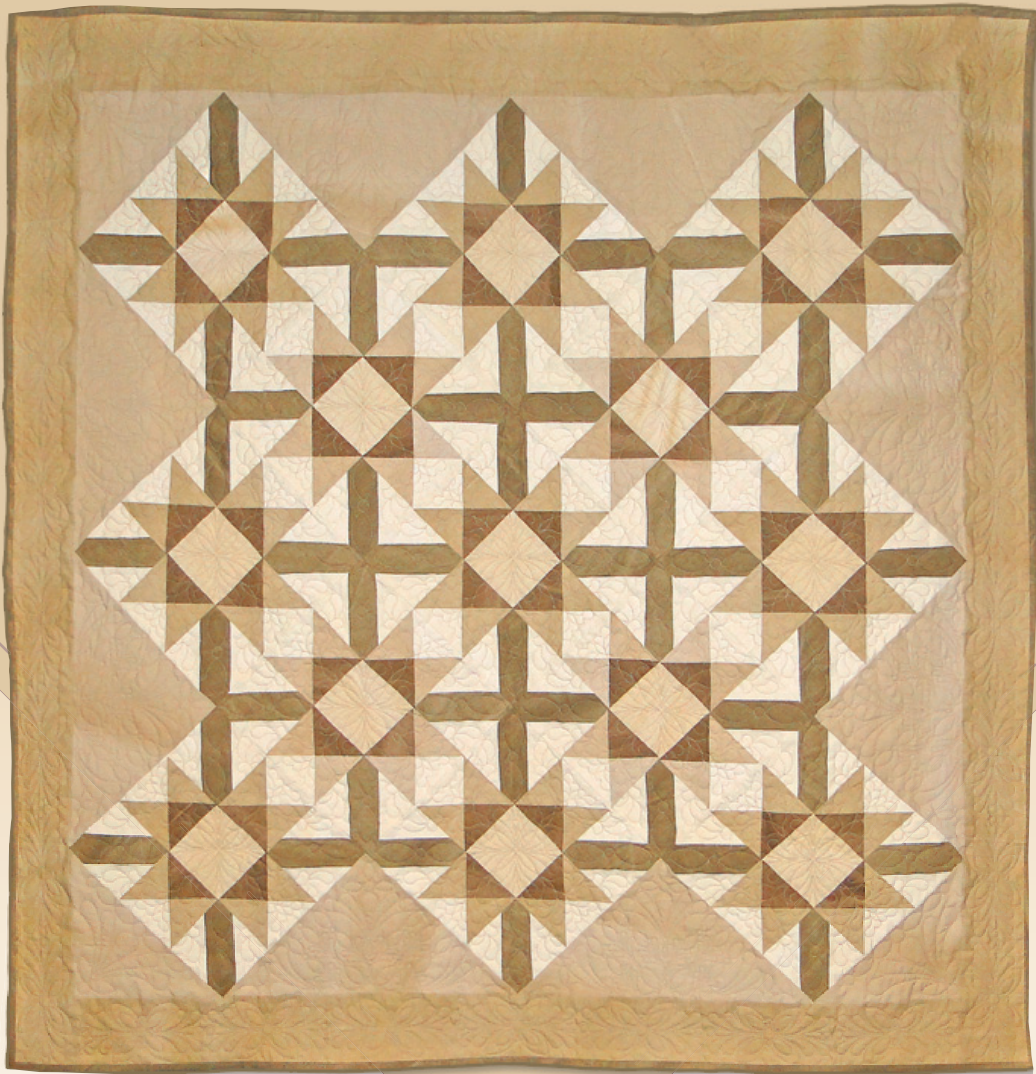


Muslin Stars

Using Aged Muslins by Marcus Fabrics



Block finished size: 9" square

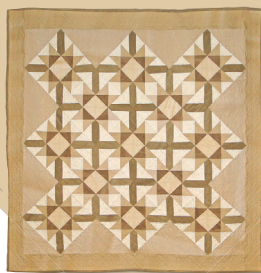
Quilt finished size: 44 1/2" square

Aged Muslin Fabric Requirements:

Y141-138D	5/8 yard, for Piece A	Y139-141D	3 yards, for Side and Corner Setting Triangles and Backing
Y138-142D	1 yard, for Pieces B and C	Y141-138D	3/8 yard, for Binding
3616-3616	1/4 yard, for Piece D (Unit A)	Y140-140D	Outer Border
Y139-141D	1 yard, for Piece D (Unit B)		
33614-3614	3/8 yard, for Piece E		
3611-3611	1/3 yard, for Piece F	Batting	50" square

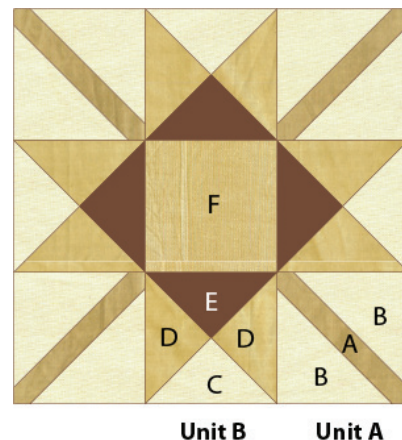

QUILT PATTERN



Block A

Make 4



Muslin used in Block A:

Y141-138D	Piece A	(16) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares.
Y138-142D	Piece B	(32) 2 5/8" x 2 5/8" squares.
Y138-142D	Piece C	(4) 4 1/4" x 4 1/4" squares, cut on both diagonals.
3616-3616	Piece D	(8) 4 1/4" x 4 1/4" squares, cut on both diagonals.
3614-3614	Piece E	(4) 4 1/4" x 4 1/4" squares, cut on both diagonals.
3611-3611	Piece F	(4) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares.

Unit A

Make 4

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each Piece B.
 2. Place 2 Piece B squares on opposite corners of a Piece A square, making sure the drawn lines are parallel.
 3. Sew on the drawn lines. Trim the seam allowances to 1/4" and press away from the center.
- This unit should measure 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" square.

Unit B

Make 16 (4 per block)

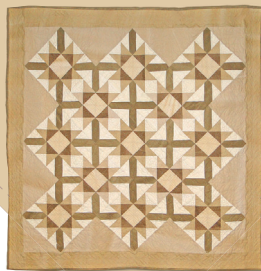
1. Sew a Piece C to the short side of a Piece D, making 4 per block.
 2. Sew a Piece D to the short side of a Piece F, making 4 per block.
 3. Sew the Step 1 and 2 units together, forming a quarter-square unit.
- This unit should measure 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" square.

Finish the Block

1. Sew a Unit A on each side of a Unit B to make the top and bottom rows.
2. Sew a Unit B on each side of a Piece F to make the center row.
3. Sew rows together. The block should measure 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" square.

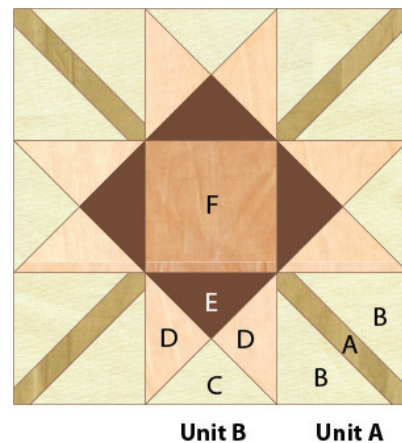

Block B

Make 9



Muslin used in Block B:

Y141-138D	Piece A	(36) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares.
Y138-142D	Piece B	(72) 2 5/8" x 2 5/8" squares.
Y138-142D	Piece C	(9) 4 1/4" x 4 1/4" squares, cut on both diagonals.
Y139-141D	Piece D	(18) 4 1/4" x 4 1/4" squares, cut on both diagonals.
3614-3614	Piece E	(9) 4 1/4" x 4 1/4" squares, cut on both diagonals.
3611-3611	Piece F	(9) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares.

Using the instructions for Unit A, make 9 blocks in this colorway.

Quilt Center:

- Y139-141D 2) 25" x 50" pieces, cut from the length of the fabric, for backing. Set aside.
 (2) 14" x 14" squares, cut on both diagonals, for 8 Side Setting Triangles.
 (2) 7 1/4" x 7 1/4" squares, cut once on the diagonal, for 4 Corner Setting Triangles.
 Note – Setting Triangles are cut oversize.

1. Sew diagonal rows together, using Side Setting triangles and alternating A and B blocks.
2. Sew rows together.
3. Add Corner Setting Triangles.
4. Trim Setting and Corner Triangles 1/4" beyond block corners.

Outer Border:

Y141-138D (5) 3 1/2" x 42" strips

1. Measure quilt length through center. Cut 2 Border pieces to this measurement. Sew to each side of quilt.
2. Sew remaining border strips together with diagonal seams to make one long strip.
3. Measure quilt width through center. Cut 2 Border pieces to this measurement. Sew to top and bottom of quilt.

Backing:

Y139-141D

1. Sew backing pieces together on long side.
2. Layer backing, batting and quilt top.
3. Quilt.

Binding:

Y141-138D (5) 2 1/4" x 42" strips

1. Sew binding strips together with diagonal seams to make one long strip.
2. Press binding in half lengthwise, wrong sides together.
3. Sew binding to quilt top, mitering at corners.
4. Turn binding to quilt back, covering seam line and sew to quilt back.
