

## CUTTING DIRECTIONS

#### WOF = Width of fabric

#### Fabric A – 28700 X

• (1) 22  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 38  $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle, centered on the panel.

### Fabric B – 28704 K

- (2) 2" x 38 ½" WOF strips.
  (2) 2" x 25 ½" WOF strips.
- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 56  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 1 1/2" x 42 1/2" strips, piece as needed.
- (160) Template 1 shapes.
- (80) Template 2 arcs.

#### Fabric C – 28702 J

• (3) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 4 1/2" squares.

#### Fabric D – 28704 H

• (160) Template 2 arcs.

#### Fabric E – 28703 O

• (80) Template 1 shapes.

#### Fabric F – 28704 P

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 58 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2)  $2'' \times 45 \frac{1}{2}''$ strips.

### Fabric G – 28702 H

- (4) 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6 1/2" x 61 1/2" strips.
- (3) 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 57  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

### Fabric H – 28705 O

• (7) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × WOF strips for the binding.

### Backing – 28702 K

• (2) 65" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 65" x 81" back.

Use a <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" seam allowance throughout. Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.


## **Block Assembly**

1. Sew (1) 2" x 38 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 1/2" x 38 1/2" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 25 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle. Trim the block to measure 24 ½" x 40 ½" to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).




Find and mark the center of the curve on (1) Fabric **B**Template 1 piece and (1) Fabric D Template 2 piece. Align the (2) pieces, right sides together, matching the center mark on each piece. Pin the (2) pieces together at the center mark, then at each end. Continue to pin as needed (Fig. 2).



 Carefully sew the (2) pieces together using a ¼" seam (Fig. 3). Flip open the sewn unit and press to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 4). The square should measure 2 ½" square.

4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (160) Unit 1 squares total.





**5.** Repeat **Steps 2-3** and refer to Figure 5 for fabric identification and placement to make (80) **Unit 2** squares.





6. Sew (2) Unit 1 squares together along the Fabric B sides to make (1) Unit 3 strip (Fig. 6).Repeat to make (80) Unit 3 strips total.



7. Sew (1) Unit 2 square to each end of (1) Unit 3 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 3 strip to each side of (1) 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"
Fabric C square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1) 8 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Block One square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (20) Block One squares total.


8. Sew together (5) **Block One** squares to make (1) **Side Border** (Fig. 8). Repeat to make a second **Side Border**.

**9.** Sew together (5) **Block One** squares to make the **Top Border** (Fig. 9). Repeat to make the **Bottom Border**.



# **Quilt Top Assembly**

Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.

**10.** Sew (1) **Side Border** to each side of the **Center Block**.

**11.** Sew the **Top Border** and **Bottom Border** to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.

**12.** Sew (1) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 56  $\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric B** strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42  $\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric B** strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.

**13.** Sew (1)  $2'' \times 58 \frac{1}{2}''$  **Fabric F** strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1)  $2'' \times 45 \frac{1}{2}''$  **Fabric F** strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.


**14.** Sew (1) 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 61  $\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric G** strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 57  $\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric G** strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block** to make the quilt top.

**15.** Layer and quilt as desired.

**16.** Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF **Fabric H** strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

**17.** Bind as desired
